SAFE Work Awards

SAFE Work Manitoba gives out three awards each year: a Worker SAFEty Award (for an individual worker), a SAFEty and Health Committee Award (for a workplace safety and health committee), and a SAFEty Culture Award (for a workplace). The Canadian Society of Safety Engineers (CSSE) annually holds a week-long celebration called North American Occupational Safety and Health (NAOSH) Week, where employers, workers and all partners in occupational health and safety collaborate to promote injury and illness prevention in the workplace.
